Dear Students and Parents,

The course offerings for Session 1 of the After School Activity Program included in this brochure begin the week of October 6th and end mid/late November or early December, running approximately 6-8 weeks, excluding professional development days, conferences, and holidays. To register for a course, please send a completed registration form and a **check made out to the *Old Rochester Regional School District*** with your child no later than **Monday, SEPTEMBER 22ND**.

Courses will be filled on a first come, first served basis. To help with courses that fill to capacity, you may wish to indicate a second choice on the registration form. **If no second choice is indicated and a course is full prior to receiving your accurate registration and check, then your registration and check will be returned.**

Tuition-based, after school programming is intended to expand, enrich, and enhance student learning in diverse extracurricular subject areas, classes, and activities. Our goal is to expand children's horizons and enrich their personal lives by exposing them to a variety of exploration on an elementary level. Exemplary behavior is expected. Anything less may result in student removal from the program after one warning.

Parents are expected to arrive at the BACK ENTRANCE to RMS, promptly at the dismissal time. Failure to do so will result in the removal of students from the program with a forfeiture of the course's tuition. The back door is the pick-up location and instructors need to see you face-to-face in order to ensure safe dismissal. If alternative pick-up arrangements are needed, a note to the office in the morning is required. If a student is not able to attend an activity on a given day, a note is also required.

Students who are absent from school will not be allowed to participate in the After School Activity on the day(s) of absence. Tuition will not be refunded after the first day of the course for any reason. Tuition assistance due to financial hardship is available on a limited basis. Please contact me with your specific need, **PRIOR TO REGISTERING.**

To register, please return to me the completed registration form, along with a properly completed check **(payable to *ORR School District*)**. **Be sure to include with your payment, the registration fee of \$10 per family. This fee is due at the time of registration for each and every session, and should be included with your total payment. It is a single fee to be paid in addition to the course tuition, regardless of the number of children and/or courses enrolled per family.**
